2023 has been an unforgettable year for the Heath Family. On April 18, I had quadruple bypass surgery, which was followed by 5 months of a variety of rehab work. On July 4, we had to take my wife, Kathy, to the emergency room at Mary

Immaculate Hospital. She was admitted to the hospital and spent the next 14 days going through all kinds of tests. The doctors who worked with Kathy said that she has Pulmonary Hypertension and that is usually treated with medications and oxygen. This condition has drastically limited her mobility and activities.

Kathy and I are blessed to have some very gifted doctors working with us as we face these current health challenges. We are confident in them and their treatment plans. But what has been the greatest source of strength and encouragement for us has been the many people who have been praying for us during this past 5 months. The cards and words of encouragement and prayers we have received from so many of our Mid-Tidewater family has been such a blessing to us as we face our health challenges. We have not been discouraged, we have not thrown in the towel, and we have certainly not given up. We thank God for each of you and your prayers, as well as our doctors who have provided with us such great profession care.

I am back in the office most Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays unless Kathy or I have doctor appointments. Kathy is not able to drive now but that should change in the near future. I have 3 weeks left on my Cardiac Rehab which takes place 3 mornings each week. So both of us can see some light at the end of the tunnel. Of course I am always available by calling my cell phone regardless of what day it is (804-921-3658).

I want to thank our Office Manager, Barbara Bareford, for the wonderful way she has maintained our MTBA office and ministries during my surgery and recovery. I just don't know how we would have managed without her presence during my absence. We are so blessed to have her on our MTBA staff. She is the best in my book.
